Successful graduates will be equipped with didactic education and clinical experience sufficient to meet postprimary pathway requirements to apply for registry through the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT).

Program Pre-Requisites

• Applicants to the Computed Tomography Program **must** currently hold ARRT credentials in an approved supporting discipline listed below:

- Radiography

- Applicants to the program must have two years of recent direct patient care in an area of medical imaging
- Students will require daily access to a computer and internet service.
