by the Numbers



58 taxi or transportation vouchers and gas cards were funded at PMH and WMC for patients needing help getting to appointments or home from a hospital visit.



33 training courses and certifications were covered for employees throughout the system to help grow their expertise.



38 SCHOLARSHIPS were awarded to high school and college students through funds at PMH, SMH, WAR, WMH, and WMC, helping grow the next generation of healthcare in our communities.



BIKE HELMETS were funded for local community outreach events.



OVER \$42,700 was granted through the Angel Fund to support non-medical essentials for local cancer patients in financial need.



The **FIVE ANNUAL** conferences and symposiums returned in 2022, providing continuing education opportunities for more than 700 employees.



The dedicated **NEONATAL INTENSIVE CARE UNIT**

(NICU) staff organized a huge reunion for over 1,000 NICU graduates and their families. The Foundation proudly supports this event to ensure it is free for children and their families to come back and share their progress with their care team.

Rooted in Rural Healthcare: \$1M USDA Grant awarded to Page Memorial Hospital Development Fund to address Rural Health Challenges



The grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture will help remediate the impact of COVID-19 and improve health and access to care in Page County. The multi-year initiative will be led by Page Memorial Hospital (PMH) and in partnership with Page County, Page County Public Schools and the Page Alliance for Community Action (PACA).

The project focuses on empowering residents with tools that can transform their care and improve their health. PMH President and Valley Health Vice President N. Travis Clark shared that over the past several years, the Valley Health team mobilized in unprecedented ways to set up telehealth options, testing sites, and other processes to safeguard patients, staff and families. "We are excited to have USDA support to further our work, applying what we learned from the pandemic to address emergency and chronic health issues in our community," said Clark.

Key components include:

- Remote monitoring systems for an estimated 100 patients
- A telehealth pilot project with Page County Schools for on-demand access to care
- Community Health Worker - trained nursing staff will serve as a link between patients and service providers to help navigate care and provide healthy strategies.
- RAM (Remote Area Medical) Clinic – will return to deliver free medical, vision and dental care to uninsured and underinsured Page County residents.
- Community Garden and Food Pilot Program

Relaxation Rooms Create Spaces for Staff to Relax and Recharge

Our valued caregivers need resources to pause, reflect, and recharge. We started in 2021 at Shenandoah Memorial Hospital and Page Memorial Hospital, and then in 2022, the addition of Relaxation Rooms at Winchester Medical Center created a place that is easily accessible and private in order for our dedicated caregivers to decompress. Valley Health Foundations purchased massage chairs for each room. The four rooms became available for staff use in early summer and average about 200 visits a month by employees. A traveling ribbon cutting organized by the Morale and Welfare Committee officially unveiled the rooms and helped remind us all that it's okay to care for ourselves and take a restorative break. Three more rooms are planned to open at Winchester Medical Center in the future.
