Serving our Community

by the Numbers

47 taxi or transportation vouchers and gas cards were funded at PMH and WMC for patients needing help getting to appointments or home from a hospital visit.

PINK RIBBON returned in person with 315 donors and guests over two days celebrating laughter, comfort, and hope. The exciting raffle raised an additional \$12,710 for Wellspring.

31 SCHOLARSHIPS were awarded to high school and college students helping grow the next generation of healthcare in our communities.



The STAMINA PROGRAM

for Shenandoah County public schools returned. In the fall and

spring, Valley Health Rehab staff visit the schools to help educate elementary school students about **healthy nutrition habits** and offer fun options for **physical activity**.

OVER \$43,900 was granted through the **Angel Fund** to support non-medical essentials for local cancer patients in financial need.

FIVE conferences and symposiums were held in 2023, providing continuing education opportunities for more than 500 employees.

Moxi robots welcomed to Winchester Medical Center



Moxi is a robot that helps our caregivers with routine tasks so they can focus on what they do best: patient care. Four Moxi robots are hard at work throughout Winchester Medical Center. They are helpful team members that work with our nurses by performing those time-consuming tasks that would normally take them away from their patients. These non-patient facing tasks include: delivering lab samples, running patient supplies, fetching items from central supply, and distributing lightweight equipment. Designed to be compatible with the busy hospital

environment, Moxi's technical features include:

- Social intelligence: opens elevators and doors on its own, won't bump into people or objects in hallways, happily poses for selfies.
- Mobile manipulation: interacts with the hospital's existing environment such as ADA doors and elevators to gain access across the entire facility.
- **Human-guided learning:** The more staff uses Moxi, the more Moxi learns and adapts to the environment and way of doing things.

Funding for the first two Moxi robots was generously provided by the Winchester Medical Center Foundation.

Thanking and Appreciating Our Team
